MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

Min No 42/18 - A170 Footpath

NYCC has agreed to clear the footpath between the lay-by on the north side of the road eastward along the stone wall. They will also clear the turf along the existing path from the point where it disappears, eastward to Church Lane junction. Highways may cut the verge towards Church Lane if time allows. It was therefore,

Min No 42/18 - Pinfold

An email had been received from Clair Sheilds (NYMNPA) asking if the parish council had any objections to the Pinfold being used as a training aid for Mr Nigel Copsey (Earth Stone & Lime Company) to train volunteers to re-point and mix lime mortars to repair traditional structures/buildings within the National Park.

Members agreed to this request. At this point it was unclear whether the re-pointing the coping stones would be undertaken. Therefore, it was agreed that if this work was not included then the quote from Mr Hunter would be accepted to carry out these works. It was agreed that the clerk would contact Clair Sheilds to clear up this misunderstanding.

RESOLVED: That the above decisions be agreed. **62/18**

*(after the meeting the clerk contacted Clair Sheilds who stated that **ALL** the work that was necessary to be undertaken on the Pinfold would be done. If the works could not be completed in the time given, NYMNPA will contact Mr Hunter (contractor) to complete the works at their expense. Therefore, the parish council would not have to undertake any repairs and the total costs would be met by NYMNPA).*
