Application: For relocation of one pole with two attached CCTV cameras to the south side of the site entrance together with removal of one pole and relocation of the two associated CCTV cameras onto the roadside building and street lamp (part retrospective)

Location: Dale Farm, Hutton Buscel

RESOLVED: That the parish council's observations are as follows:

1. Objection to the CCTV pole on Dale Lane and suggest that it is positioned further down the entrance to the site. This will ensure that there will be a better view of all vehicles accessing & leaving the site and will not infringe upon the privacy of individuals walking/driving through to the Main Street.

2. Object to the siting of the CCTV cameras onto the street light as is an antique lamp post and placing any items on it will detract from its heritage. **88/22**
